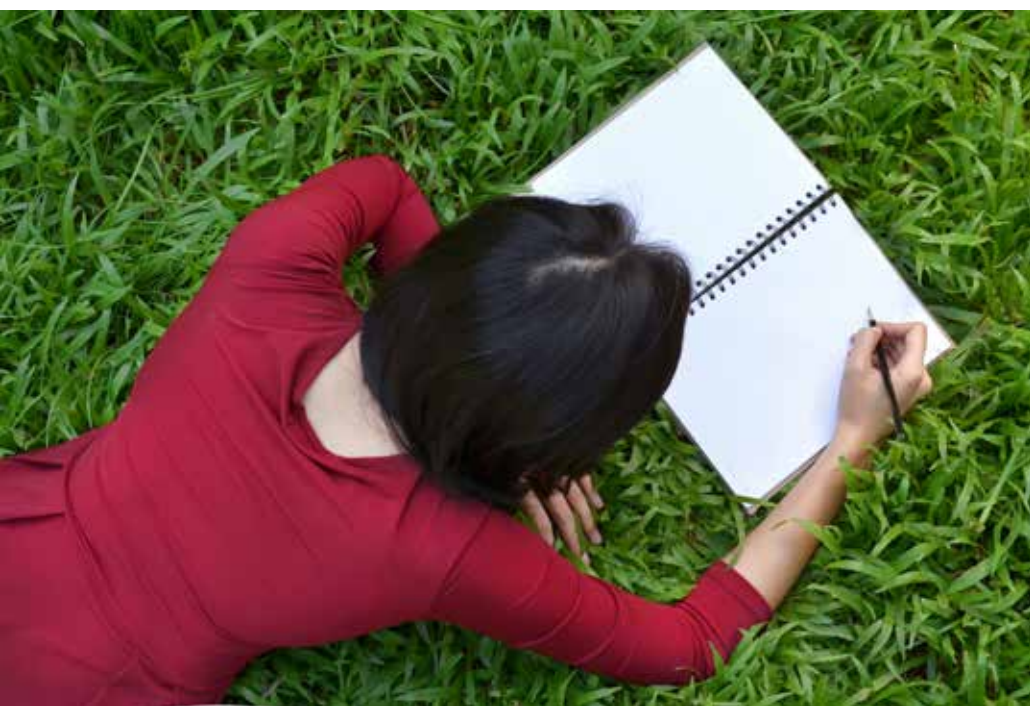
THE WALKING SEMINAR

The Walking Seminar is an innovative special topics seminar that engages students in a territorial investigation of the North Carolina landscape. Through research and creative communication, students in the class will foster a means for understanding their location and documenting their experience. Using the path as a guiding metaphor, the aesthetic and visual character of our journey will be designed to encourage , sustained, experimental, and creative responses.
