A Different World In Your Own Backyard

Located in southeastern North Carolina, the Lumbee Indians are the largest Native American tribe east of the Mississippi and the ninth largest tribe in the United States. North Carolina has the largest Native American population of any state east of the Mississippi. This course will unveil Lumbee history and culture in a useable way, revealing how the past resonates in the present. Students will learn through readings, in-class discussions and films, and by conducting multimedia research projects that help Lumbee history come alive for the general public. A trip to the Lumbee homeland of Robeson County will be included in the course. No course fees.
